Purpose: This group will oversee and coordinate the activities of relevant working groups in progressing the policy framework underpinning an enhanced national electricity market. It will be responsible for the overall narrative and positioning of RenewableUK in relation to market reform work.

Key priorities (2025-2027)

- Strategic positioning: influencing the shape and direction of Reformed National Pricing Delivery Plan due to be published in Q4 2025.
- With involvement of relevant working groups, develop the overarching RUK position on RNM, with clear positions or principles around key elements: network charging, constraints management, SSEP, balancing and settlement arrangements
- Oversee the engagement strategy with key stakeholders to progress key aspects of enhanced national market, and develop messaging for media engagement.
- Oversee the work across relevant working groups and commission work packages as needed.

Wider governance/TA/industry interaction

This group will coordinate and steer the activities of relevant RUK groups including Market Design, Charging, International Market Integration, and Systems & Flexibility. We will also coordinate closely with wider RUK SSEP workstream.
