

Cymru Strategic Working Group

Frequency of meetings: Quarterly

Purpose: *Provide a strategic steer for RenewableUK Cymru, ensuring maximum opportunity and efficacy to influence key policy developments impacting member interests*

Scope of Work

Provide direction and support to create a Cymru strategy for the election and an outlook for the subsequent 2–3-year period.

Drive positive progress on devolved policies affecting the Welsh environment for clean energy projects – including planning & consenting, community benefit, local ownership, grid buildout, skills, aviation and supply chain.

Encourage cross-party support for renewable energy, including creating a robust basis for an enduring sector deal that goes beyond the current government term.

Wider governance/TA/industry interaction

This group will sit under the RenewableUK Strategic Committee and will ensure strategic alignment and coordination across both RenewableUK and RUK Cymru on both devolved and reserved matters.
